Alexander Müller, male, born in 1969, German citizen, employee representative. Member of the Supervisory Board of the OSRAM Licht AG, current term of office until 2027.

Alexander Müller has many years of experience in industrial manufacturing and extensive expertise in employee representation within the OSRAM Group. He began his professional career with OSRAM GmbH in 1988 at the Herbrechtingen site, where he initially worked as a production mechanic in manufacturing.

Since 1994, Mr. Müller has been continuously involved in employee co-determination. Following his election to the Works Council of OSRAM GmbH at the Herbrechtingen site, he assumed the position of a full-time Works Council member in 2006. Since 2010, he has served as Chairman of the Works Council of OSRAM GmbH at the Herbrechtingen site. In this role, he represents the interests of employees and is closely involved in matters relating to co-determination, work organization and site development.

Since 2022, Mr. Müller has also been Chairman of the Central Works Council of OSRAM GmbH. In this capacity, he coordinates employee representation at company level and is involved in group-wide human resources and corporate policy matters.

Prior to his activities in employee representation, Mr. Müller worked for many years as a production mechanic at OSRAM GmbH. In addition, he completed his civilian service from 1991 to 1992 at Lebenshilfe in Heidenheim. He obtained his professional qualification through vocational training as a motor vehicle mechanic.
